MARRIAGE LICENSE FEES:

Duplicates	\$ 6.00
Amendments	\$ 30.00 (Requires A Court Order)
Each Additional Certified Copy	\$ 2.50
Administration Of Oaths	\$ 3.00
Stamped Envelopes	\$ 1.00
Photo Copy	\$ 1.00
Search Fee	\$ 1.50

Fees are payable at the time of application. No personal/business checks accepted. Cash, money orders, cashiers checks, and credit cards (Visa, Master Card, and American Express) are accepted at all locations. Marriage License fees are non-refundable.

MARRIAGE LICENSE INFORMATION:

- **Both parties must apply in person, at the same time.**
- There is a 3-day waiting period before a ceremony may be performed for all Florida Residents, unless waived by presentation of a valid premarital course certificate for both parties, from a registered provider. The premarital course provider registry is accessible in the marriage division or on the internet at www.browardclerk.org in the "frequently asked questions" section, under marriage. (See clerk for certificate requirements).

The "Family Law Handbook" should be read prior to obtaining the Marriage License. The "Family Law handbook" is available for viewing in the Clerk of Courts Marriage and One-Stop-Divisions or on the Internet at www.flclerks.com.

- License is valid for sixty (60) days from effective date.
- If previously married, the exact date of death, divorce, or annulment of the last marriage is required.
- No ceremonies performed for those couples that arrive after 4:00 p.m.

ALL IDENTIFICATION MUST BE VALID AND CURRENT (NO EXPIRED I.D. ACCEPTED), MUST HAVE CORRECTLY SPELLED LEGAL NAME AND CORRECT DATE OF BIRTH.

FIRST FORM:

- One Federal Or State Government Issued Photo Identification With Signature And Date Of Birth Required. We Accept:

Driver's License
Passport

State I.D. Card
Military I.D.
Naturalization Certificate

And

SECOND FORM (if applicable)

Anyone who has been issued a social security number must provide that number. Any person who is not a citizen of the U.S., may provide either a Social Security number or an Alien Registration number if one has been issued.

Applicants are required to provide one self-addressed stamped envelope for the return of their certified copy after the certificate has been recorded. [This may be purchased at the marriage counter for \$1.00].

APPLICANTS UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE:

- Above applicable I.D. and:
- A certified copy of his/her birth certificate is required for proof of parentage and age verification.
- Consent of both parents regardless of the fact that they may be divorced or not named on the applicant's birth certificate. Consent forms may be obtained at the time of application. If one parent is deceased, a certified copy of the death certificate is required.
- Applicants under 16 years: clerk will explain procedures.
